《駐粵辦通訊》(號外)

「發展品牌、升級轉型及拓展內銷市場的專項基金」開始接受申請

香港特區政府已於 2012 年 6 月 25 日推出十億元的「發展品牌、升級轉型及拓展內銷市場的專項基金」(「BUD 專項基金」)，並開始接受申請。視乎資助餘額而定，「專項基金」的公開申請期為 5 年，至 2017 年 6 月。

「專項基金」下設「企業支援計劃」和「機構支援計劃」，分別向個別企業和非分配利潤組織提供撥款，資助他們推行有關發展品牌、升級轉型和拓展內銷的項目。

「企業支援計劃」由香港生產力促進局擔任秘書處。所有按照《商業登記條例》(第 310 章)在香港登記，並在香港有實質業務運作的非上市公司，均符合資格申請資助。申請企業需遞交一份全盤業務發展計劃，顯示如何透過建議措施提升該企業在內地市場的競爭力，促進在內地的業務發展。企業資助會按照對等原則提供，即政府最多資助個別項目總核准開支的 50%，而企業須以現金形式承擔不少於該項目總核准開支的 50%。在基金的申請期內，每家企業最多可獲資助三個核准項目。每家企業的累積資助金額上限為 50 萬元。每個項目須在 24 個月內完成。

「機構支援計劃」由工業貿易署負責推行，向非分配利潤組織(如工商組織、專業團體及研究機關等)提供資助推行較大型的項目，協助香港整體或個別行業的企業發展品牌、為業務升級轉型及拓展內銷市場，從而提升他們在內地市場的整體競爭力。每項獲批項目最多可獲基金資助 500 萬元或核准項目開支的 90%，兩者以金額較低者為準。申請機構須自行承擔餘下的 10% 項目開支，形式可以是現金、實物或贊助。每個項目最長為期 3 年。

通告「海關最新便利措施宣講會」

(一) 經貿快訊 -

1. 《關於發布實施<限制用地項目目錄 (2012 年本)>和<禁止用地項目目錄 (2012 年本)>的通知》
國土資源部、國家發展和改革委員會於 2012 年 5 月 23 日聯合發布上述《通知》，自發布之日起施行。主要內容包括：凡列入《禁止目錄》的建設項目或者採用所列工藝技術、裝備、規模的建設項目，以及凡採用《產業結構調整指導目錄 (2011 年本)》明令淘汰的落後工藝技術，裝備或者生產明令淘汰產品的建設項目，國土資源管理部門和投資管理部門一律不得辦理相關手續等。
2. 《關於福建省平潭綜合實驗區營業稅政策的通知》
財政部、國家稅務總局於 2012 年 6 月 15 日發布上述《通知》，自 2011 年 12 月 1 日起執行。主要內容包括：註冊在平潭的符合條件的物流企業，按照現行試點物流企業營業稅政策差額徵收營業稅等。
3. 《產業轉移指導目錄 (2012 年本)》
工業和信息化部於 2012 年 6 月 15 日就上述《目錄》公開徵求意見，截止日期為 2012 年 7 月 15 日。《目錄》明確了各經濟區承接產業轉移的產業帶或集聚區的發展重點、以及經濟區內各省 (區、市) 優先承接發展的行業及產品目錄。當中指出，廣東珠江三角洲地區是產業轉移的主要轉出地之一。海峽西岸經濟區和海南省環北部灣地區重點承接珠三角、台灣地區及國際的產業轉移。

4. 深圳市工傷保險繳費費率下調 20%
深圳市社會保險基金管理局於 2012 年 6 月 13 日表示，自 2012 年 7 月 1 日起，深圳市用人單位繳納工傷保險費的基準費率統一下調 20%。
5. 《深圳經濟特區商事登記若干規定 (草稿)》公開徵求意見
深圳市人民政府法制辦公室於 2012 年 6 月 19 日就上述《草稿》公開徵求意見，截止日期為 2012 年 6 月 29 日。主要內容包括：實行公民從事個體經營活動豁免商事登記制度，辦理稅務登記後可開展活動；以及申請人申請有限責任公司設立登記時，商事登記機關登記其全體股東認繳的註冊資本總額，無需登記實收資本。
6. 《東莞市促進中小微企業發展實施辦法》
東莞市人民政府於 2012 年 5 月 19 日公布上述《辦法》，有效期至 2015 年 12 月 31 日。主要內容包括：2012 年一次性安排 1000 萬元設立市促進小微企業發展資金，用於獎勵高成長性中小微工業企業等。
7. 東莞市社會保障局實施七項政策為企業減負
東莞市社會保障局將於 2012 年 7 月 1 日起實施上述政策。主要內容包括：2013 年繼續維持單位費率 11%；以及從 2012 年 7 月 1 日至 2013 年 6 月 30 日，社會基本醫療保險費企業繳納比例從 3%調整為 2.5%等。
8. 《東莞市商事登記制度改革試點工作實施方案》
東莞市人民政府於 2012 年 5 月 16 日印發上述《方案》。主要內容包括：以大朗鎮為試點，在東莞市推行商事登記制度改革；一般性經營項目全部放開，許可經營項目涉及的許可審批一律改為後置；以及簡化商事主體登記事項、取消新設外資項目合同章程審批、取消企業登記的住所產權證明等。

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9. 《關於促進總部經濟發展的補充意見》

福建省人民政府於 2012 年 6 月 2 日發布上述《補充意見》。主要內容包括：對符合條件的本地現有總部企業按規定提供經營貢獻獎勵和規費減免或返還等。

江西

10. 《江西省工傷職工停工留薪期管理暫行辦法》

江西省人力資源和社會保障廳於 2012 年 6 月 12 日發布上述《辦法》，自發布之日起施行。主要內容包括：停工留薪期一般不超過 12 個月；以及工傷職工在停工留薪期內或者尚未作出勞動能力鑒定結論的，用人單位不得與之解除或者終止勞動合同等。
